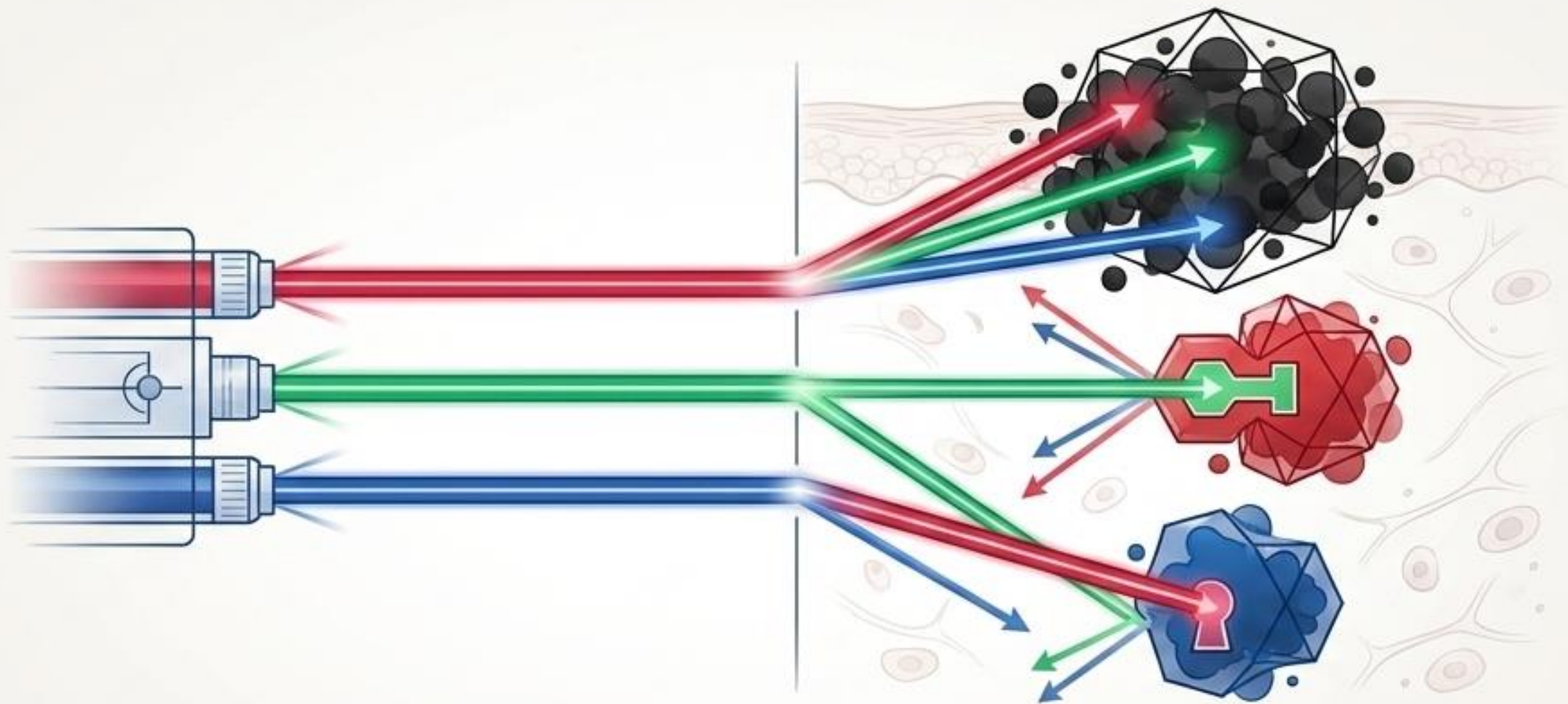


Shattering the Size Barrier with Laser Physics



Modern laser technology does not physically remove or 'burn away' tattooed skin. It delivers carefully controlled, extremely short pulses of energy. The absorbed energy produces a rapid physical effect, breaking large particles into progressively smaller fragments.

Matching Wavelengths to Specific Pigment Colors



The Broad Net

Dark pigments, particularly black ink, absorb a broad spectrum of light and respond highly favorably to treatment.

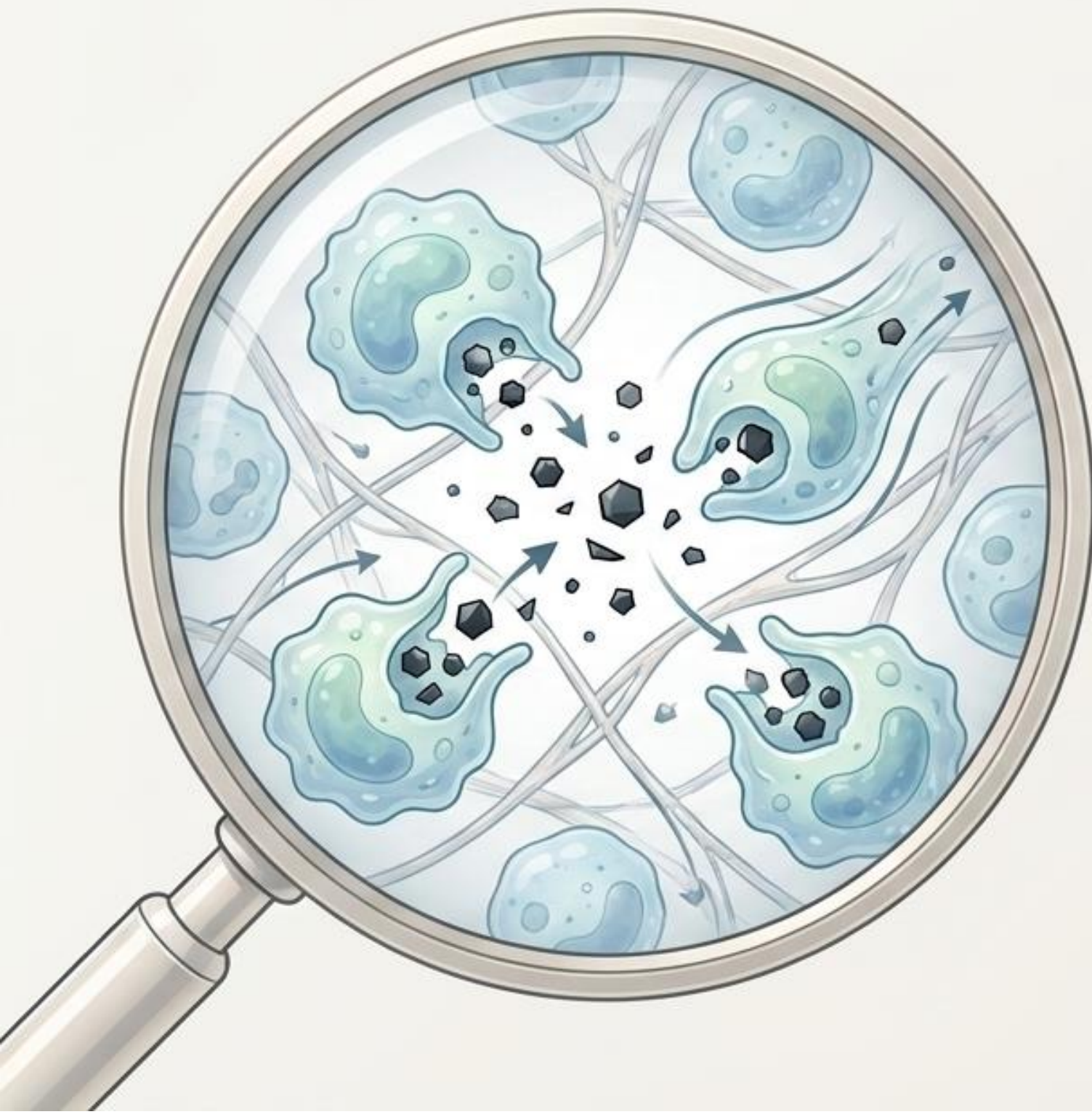
The Precise Lock

Multicolored tattoos require exact wavelength matches to effectively interact with their distinct chemical formulations.

The Result

A single laser cannot erase all colors. Professional removal requires sophisticated mapping of distinct wavelengths to specific pigments.

The Immune System as the Ultimate Eraser



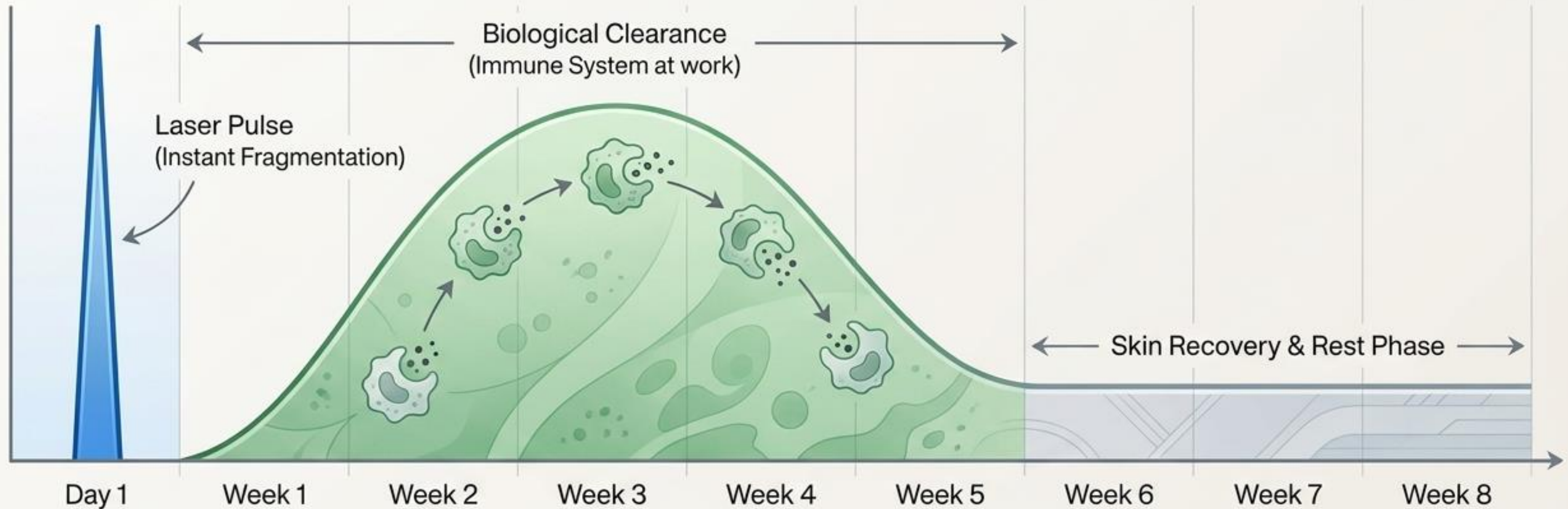
The Body's Role

The laser performs only the first part of tattoo removal. Once the energy fragments the pigment, the body's natural clearance mechanisms begin scavenging the newly created tiny particles.

Continuous Fading

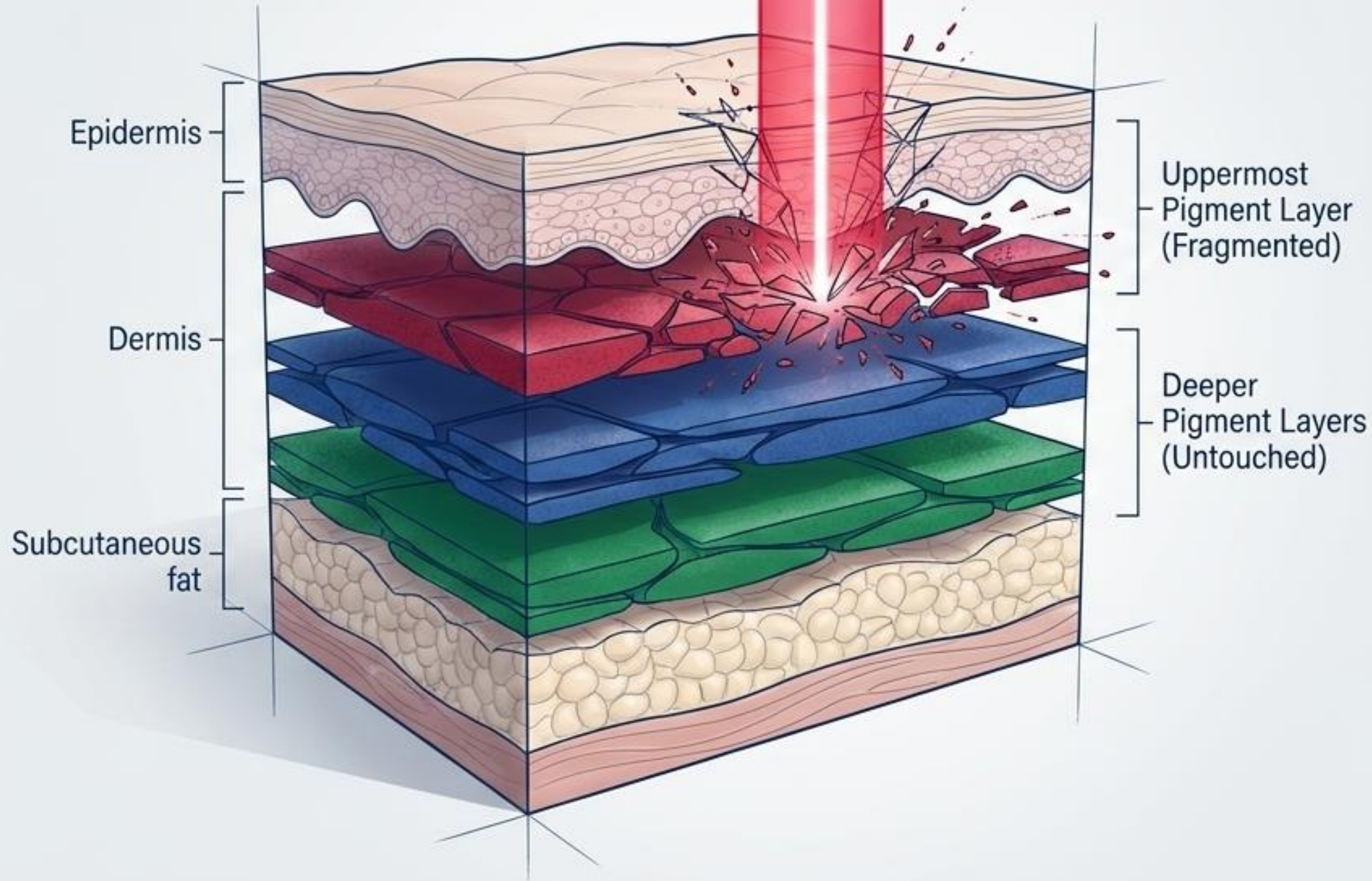
Because of this biological engine, fading happens gradually in the weeks between sessions, not instantly in the treatment chair.

The Biological Timeline of a Single Treatment



Treating the area more frequently does not speed up the removal process. The skin requires time to safely recover, and the immune system requires time to process the disrupted pigment. An appropriate treatment schedule perfectly syncs laser technology with biological reality.

Peeling Back Layers of Pigment



- A dense tattoo contains substantial amounts of pigment at varying depths.
- Attempting to deliver enough energy to destroy all pigment at once would overwhelm and damage surrounding tissue.
- Professional treatment uses a safe, progressive approach: targeting only a portion of the uppermost pigment per session.
- As the top layer clears, subsequent treatments safely reach deeper layers of ink.

Diagnosing Fading Speed and Ink Resistance

Removal speed is an individualized interaction between ink density, age, and natural biological clearance. Two visually similar tattoos may fade at different rates.

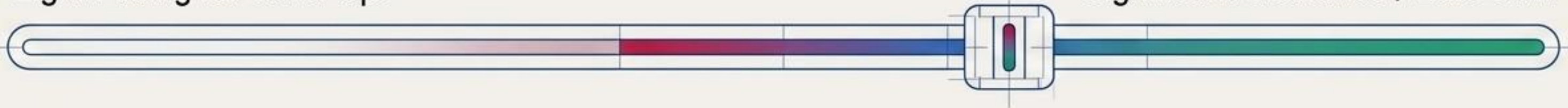

✓ Older tattoo age (natural degradation)	● ● Newer tattoos
✓ Lightly applied amateur application	● ● Heavily saturated professional application
✓ Single-layer designs	● ● Cover-ups (multiple overlapping ink layers)
✓ Black or dark ink pigments	● ● Resistant, multi-colored pigments
✓ Locations with high blood flow	● ● Extremities with lower circulation

Success doesn't always mean perfectly bare skin. Many patients only require enough fading to prepare a clean canvas for a new cover-up design.



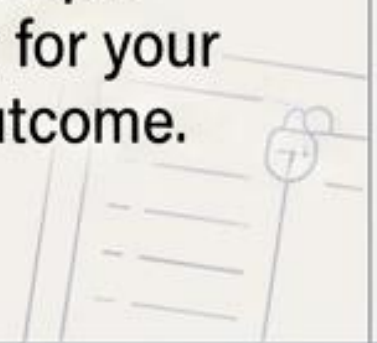
The Variables

Final results are dictated by the chemical resistance of the specific ink, density of layers, and individual immune response.

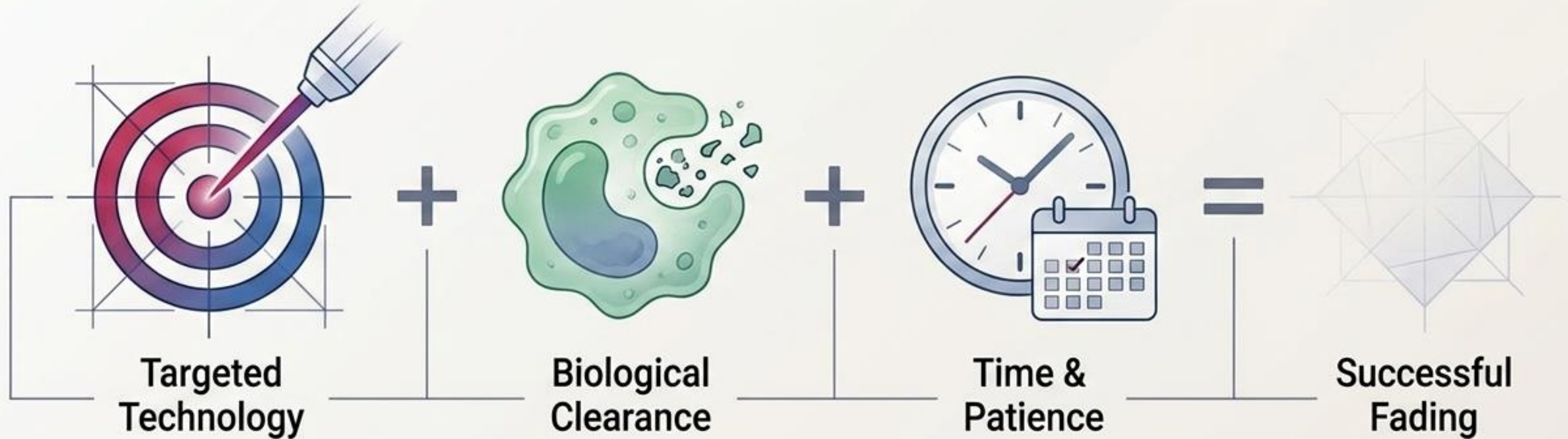
